ABOUT THE COLLECTION SYSTEM:

The Collection System is owned, operated and maintained by the Town of Gibsonville. It consists of approximately 47.7 miles of Gravity Sewer Lines, 2.1 miles of Forced Mains (pressure sewer lines) and 4 Sewage Pump Stations. Each day the town transports an average of 320,000 gallons of untreated wastewater to the South Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant, and an average of 250,000 gallons of untreated wastewater to the East Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant for final treatment.

SYSTEM PERFORMANCE:

The Town of Gibsonville's personnel work very hard to ensure that our Collection System is maintained and operated at a high standard. The Town is pleased to report there were no reportable sanitary sewer overflows during the 2015 calendar year.
